Verb Moods

Mood	Definition
Indicative	Used to make a statement
Imperative	Used for commands or direct requests
Subjunctive	Used to speculate or express a wish
Conditional	Expresses an action or idea that is dependent on a condition. (Often begins with "If")
Interrogative	Used to ask a question

Verb Moods

Mood	Example
Indicative	Al needs to clean his room today.
Imperative	Al, clean your room today!
Subjunctive	Al wishes he were finished cleaning his room.
Conditional	If Al had cleaned his room, he could have played.
Interrogative	Have you cleaned your room yet, Al?
